Sir,

It is for your kind information and necessary perusal that the Government of Uttar Pradesh has notified *Vivek University, Moradabad Road, Bijnor* as a State Private University vide Notification No. F.499/79-V-1-2024-1-K-29-2024 dated 26.12.2024 and all colleges working under Shivika Educational Society has become the constituent college of Vivek University Bijnor.

In continuation of the above, the meeting of the Executive Council held on 23.12.2024 (Agenda Nos. 2 and 3) resolved that Vivek College of Ayurvedic Sciences and Hospital, Bijnor shall remain affiliated with *Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath AYUSH University, Gorakhpur* up to the academic session 2024–25. Thereafter, from the academic session 2025–26 onwards, it shall function under the umbrella of *Vivek University Moradabad Road, Bijnor*.

Accordingly, it is hereby informed that:

1. All examinations up to the academic session 2024–25 shall be conducted by *Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath AYUSH University, Gorakhpur* as per the existing affiliation.
2. From the academic session 2025–26 onwards, the examination body shall be *Vivek University, Bijnor*, and all academic, administrative, and examination-related matters shall be governed as per the Statutes and Ordinances of the Vivek University Bijnor.

3. The College is directed to ensure necessary compliance and coordination with the concerned authorities for a smooth transition of affiliation and examination processes.

Subject:- Grant of Extended Permission to Vivek College of Ayurvedic Sciences & Hospital, Mandahai Road, Post-Agr, Distt. Bijnor-246701, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0388) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 28 of NCTISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26-reg.

Sir/Madam,

- To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructural facilities at your college namely Vivek College of Ayurvedic Sciences & Hospital, Mandahai Road, Post-Agr, Distt. Bijnor-246701, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0388), inspection was conducted on 03.04.2025 and 04.04.2025 in hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCTISM to process the permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCTISM Act, 2020.
- Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the official regulations namely the Minimum essential standards: Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2021st, provisions under the NCTISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations photo under. On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-

1) Teaching staff:-

- Availability of total teaching staff for UG (BAMS) Course as per the part I submitted by the college is $\frac{\text{Actual}}{\text{Required}} = \frac{12}{15} = 80\%$.

a. Availability of hospital staff is $\frac{\text{Total}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{11}{12} \times 100\% = 91.67\%$. (after excluding part time Modern medical staff)

2. Further, an opportunity of clarification vide letter even no. dated 03.03.2023 was provided to you. In response of the same you have submitted the clarification vide ref no. VCAS/0331/07-2023 dated 13.07.2023. The submitted documents were verified & found complying.

3. Further, the assessment report along with clarification was duly placed before the 135th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicines (NCISM) convened on 18.07.2023 and Board observed that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the concerned acts and regulations but is fulfilling the criteria in accordance with the Board's prior letter issued on 06.03.2023 & 20.01.2023. Further, the Board also observed that the college is meeting the notified & requisite criteria for the issuance of the extended permission in accordance to regulation 54(2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 by getting permitted for last three consecutive years with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) Course. Accordingly, the Board decided as follows:-

a) To issue extended permission in UG with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 as per the provision under section 26 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2023-24.

"DECISION"

1. Therefore, Vindh College of Ayurvedic Sciences & Hospital, Haradabad Road, Post-Agr, Distt. Bhojpur-246701, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYUG388) is hereby granted with:-

a) Extended permission in UG (BAMS) course with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) for the academic session 2023-24 in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 and;

b) The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 53 (2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31st December, 2023 to be considered for the permission for the academic session 2024-2027:-

i) Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats in UG Course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or so the vice may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

ii) It is also informed that determination of fee and other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. MESS/Reg/ASU/2022 is dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of the National Regulatory Committee (NRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.

3. Approvals made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
